## 4. Recitative (Tenor)

Those towards the Organ Replacement Fund — now past the halfway mark of the project

The Building Foundation has distributed over \$1 million to the Parish for:

- The restoration, preservation, maintenance, improvement, enhancement and upkeep of the Church building it's fixtures, fittings and ornaments
- The preservation, protection, maintenance, improvement and enhancement

  Trust property of St James'
- The Building Foundation is principally a Capital Fund, which is invested to provide income to distribute to the Parish of St James'
